The benefits of fermenting apples into cider and other products have been recognised since Roman times and Willy's ACV is marketed as a health product.

The Problem

Willy's was launching a new product, a sparkling Kombucha and ACV drink. They were looking for on-shelf display packaging which would stand out from the crowd. The box also needed to be easy to carry and strong enough to take the weight of $4 \times 250 \text{ml}$ cans.

The Solution

- Our award-winning structural design team designed a complex one-piece carton with a cut-out to form a convenient carry handle.
- The boxes have a crash-lock base for quick and easy assembly.
- The new design uses less material in the construction of the boxes.
